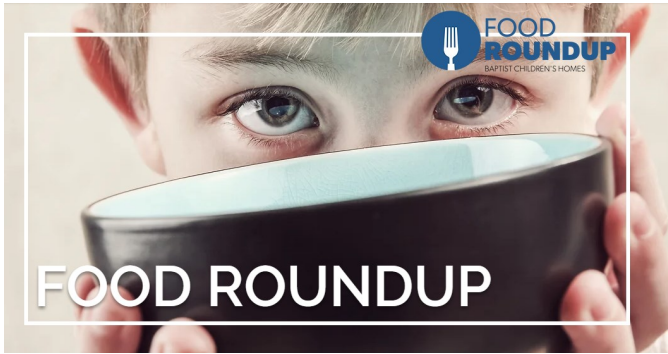
### Men's Ministry Moment: Men's Outdoor Weekend
